Do you remember the 60s and in particular the Mersey Beat? Do you sing along with affection to the music of the Beatles, Gerry and the Pacemakers, The Searchers, Merseybeats? Then why not join us on our almost 'Magical Mystery Tour' to where it all began – Liverpool. Our 4-day tour includes the benefit of a guided tour to learn more about the city and its musical history, plenty of free time in this fascinating city, a 'Ferry Across the Mersey' and a visit to Port Sunlight Village Trust, the village founded by 'Soap King' William Hesketh Lever in 1888. Don't delay, reserve your place today for a tour which has already generated a lot of interest from members, just from word of mouth alone!

Your Itinerary

Day 1

Depart from Kings Hill (approx. 08.30hrs.) and travel north, making an appropriate comfort stop en-route, to The National Memorial Arboretum in Staffordshire. Here you will have free time to use their catering facilities and wander around the magnificent grounds prior to continuing our journey to Liverpool and our hotel, The Jurys Inn, where accommodation is reserved for three nights on a bed & breakfast basis with dinner included on the first night only.

Day 2

After breakfast, a local guide will meet the coach at the hotel for a light hearted Liverpool & Beatles themed tour with some music along the route, visiting the area of the childhood homes of both John Lennon and Paul McCartney, see Penny Lane, Strawberry Fields and enjoy a panoramic city tour, passing the Beatles schools and colleges and looking at John Lennon's birthplace. We will hear the story of how The Beatles were originally managed by Allan Williams who got them their work in Hamburg. The tour will include a walk along Mathew Street and a visit to the Cavern Club and stop outside Eric's to explain the legacy left by the whole music scene in the 1960's. The tour will finish at the Double Fantasy John Lennon & Yoko Ono Exhibition, after which the afternoon will be at leisure.

Day 3

Today will be a free day for you to explore Liverpool with its Cathedrals, museums, art galleries and shopping. There may be the option of a visit to Crosby Beach (this is dependent on times of low tide) to see the famous Antony Gormley's 'Another Place' statues. During the evening, there may be an opportunity to visit a 60's musical venue, details of which are still being worked on at the time of this brochure being produced.

Day 4

Check out of the hotel following breakfast and make the short journey to Pier Head. Here we take a 'Ferry across the Mersey' to Woodside on the Wirral. From here, the coach will continue to Port Sunlight Village for a guided tour on board the coach followed by free time to visit the Museum and Lady Lever Art Gallery. The coach will depart during the mid-afternoon for the journey back to Kings Hill, arriving during the late evening.
